NITZA AGAM is a graduate of Hebrew University in Jerusalem and has a Master's Degree in English Literature and in Comparative Literature from San Francisco State University. She is a published poet and writer, and her most recent publication is in *Poetica: Reflections of Jewish Thought*.

AMY ANDRE' is a *Point Foundation Scholar* at UC Berkeley's Haas School of Business. Amy has a master's degree in sexuality studies from San Francisco State University, and writes about LGBT community topics. She is the co-author of *Bisexual Health*, a book published by the National Gay & Lesbian Task Force.

ABBY CAPLIN trained in pediatrics and became a board-certified allergist. She later earned her master's degree in counseling psychology and now practices mind-body medicine and counseling in San Francisco, where she helps people with chronic illness or medical challenges find ways to live joyful, meaningful and healthier lives.

JULIANA BIRNBAUM FOX has lived in the US, Europe, Japan, Nepal, and Brazil. For the past 12 years she has been a freelance writer focusing on environmental issues and social justice. In 2005 she founded Voices in Solidarity, a nonprofit organization that builds partnerships with native-led environmental and social projects in the Amazon rainforest.

LENORE WEISS is a 2008 Pablo Neruda Poetry Prize finalist and serves as Fiction Editor of the November 3rd Club. For three years she served as the Middle East Peace Coordinator for Kehilla Community Synagogue and recently helped to organize a "Poetry for Gaza" event which included Arab and Jewish poets reading together.
